The Ghana Society for Medical Physics (GSMP) in collaboration with a team of Lecturers from Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU) and St. Olav's University Hospital, Norway will organize a Summer School on "Quality Control and Radiation Protection in Diagnostic Imaging", from 23-27 May 2016 at the Korle-Bu Teaching Hospital.

The Summer School is targeted for Radiation Workers such as Medical Physicist, Radiographers, Biomedical Engineers, Interns, Students, etc. with great knowledge in Medical Physics, Quality Control, Radiography and Radiation Protection in Ghana.
